CARE GUIDE

Wood has gained great popularity in architecture for its natural beauty and warmth, but like all fine materials, wood requires maintenance to maintain its good condition. Scuffs and scratches are reasons wood can get damaged and can detract from its visual appeal.

PREVENTIVE MEASURES

- Avoid direct sunlight on interior wood systems. UV rays directly on the panels can cause color change due to oxidation. It is best to contact us when the interior wood is exposed to direct sunlight, we will give you recommendations in this regard.

- Avoid areas with extreme humidity, as humidity generally causes the wood to expand and thereby damage it. It is recommended to maintain an ambient temperature between 10°C and 30°C (65°F and 86°F) and a relative humidity between 25% RH and 55% RH.

- DO NOT USE abrasive cleaners as they may cause permanent damage to the finish.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

1- Periodically remove dust buildup with a static mop or dry, lint-free cloth.

2- In the event of liquid spillage, wipe off immediately with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn marks, use a soft, slightly damp cloth and wipe in the direction of the grain of the wood.

3- DO NOT USE detergents, solvent-based cleaners, chemicals or other abrasive products, as they may alter the appearance of the wood.

4- Inspect panels regularly for any potential changes in appearance as this may indicate water and moisture damage. If you observe moisture on the panels, please take immediate action to stop continued exposure to water as damage to wood products may occur after prolonged exposure.
